



**Memorandum of Affiliation between the International Society of Biomechanics in Sports and the Japanese Society of Biomechanics**

*The international Society of Biomechanics in Sports (ISBS) and the Japanese Society of Biomechanics (JSB) agree to establish an affiliation of their societies.*

*The term of this affiliation shall be for a two-year period commencing on the abovementioned date. However, provided that a request for termination of this affiliation has not arrived either from ISBS or JSB at least two months prior to the expiration date thereof, it shall be automatically extended for a two-year period commencing the expiration date of this affiliation, and the above process shall be applied thereafter.*


*This affiliation will promote the aims and objectives of the societies and their members and will facilitate collaborative initiatives.*

*Each society agrees to nominate a delegate to represent its interests and to act as liaison with the other society. For the International Society of Biomechanics in Sports, this will be the Vice President of Public Relation. For the Japanese Society of Biomechanics, a named society member nominated by the Society Board will act as this liaison.*

- 1. Each society will publish newsletters and announcements, which will be made available to members of both societies to facilitate mutual communication.*
- 2. ISBS membership entitles an individual ISBS member to attend the JSB conference with the same registration fee as JSB members, and JSB membership entitles an individual JSB member to attend the ISBS conference with the same registration fee as ISBS members.*
- 3. Members of ISBS shall not have rights to vote or hold office with JSB unless they are also a member in good standing of JSB, and vice versa.*
- 4. To be eligible for applying for financial grant support or awards from either ISBS or JSB, a candidate must satisfy the requirements and be a member in good standing of the society providing the support/award.*
